Accessible Schedules


- Put in an RFQ
- Waiting on a proposal from an individual for accessible schedules
- COMET has proceeded to use their current system but we are looking at alternatives for screen reader schedules
- We currently do not have control with the COMET system and the surrounding areas being owned by private vendors and we would have to go through different avenues
- We have looked at making bus stops more accessible and we have brought this to the board and are awaiting figuring out the process
- If it is owned by a private vendor and no permission is granted then we run into barriers that way
- We have identified in the paperwork we cover who is responsible for the upkeep of the stop
- It is important that we have someone that goes out and checks the stops for debris and other barriers
